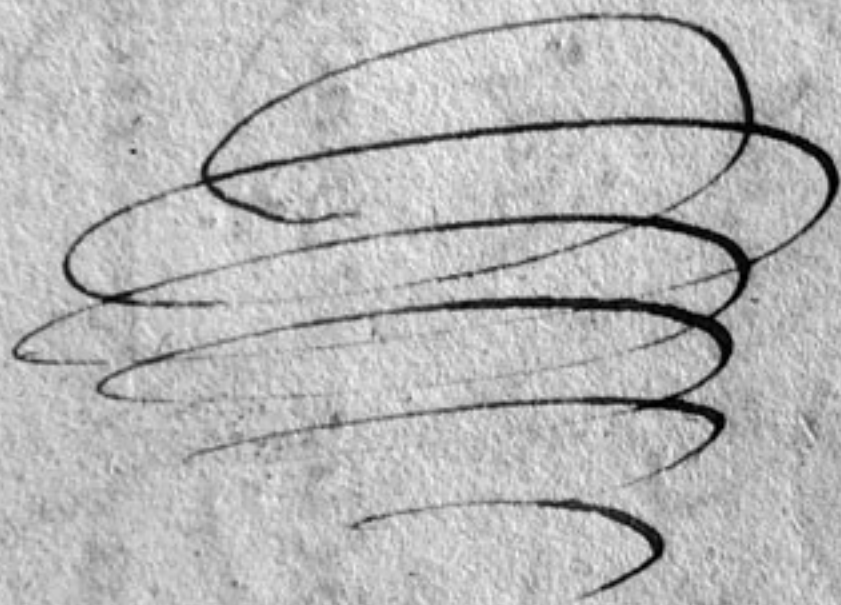

and my Body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried by my Exors^{es} here in Named
Item My will is that my debts and ffuerrall expences be first payd and discharged
Item I give and bequeath to my Son Anthony one shilling: Item I give to
my Son Christopher one shilling: and to his ffour children John Christopher Mary &
Elizabeth one shilling each: Item I give to my Son Nicholas one shilling
Item I give his two children William and Johanna one shilling each Item I give
and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Aburn one shilling: and to her two sons Phillippe
and William one shilling each: Item I give to my daughter Elizabeth wife of
John Peatman one shilling and to her son William one shilling: Item I give to
daughter Esther wife of Thomas Lomoy one shilling: Item I give to my daughter

Exoritor of this my goods and chattels whatsoever: And my will is that all those
my twelve pounce Legacies be payd by Exoritor above named att or within three
months after my decease: And I do hereby make voyd all former Wills and
testaments by me hereto fore made and do own and declare this to be my present
Last Will and testament: In Witnesse whereof I Mary Cabbell to this my
Last Will have hereunto set my hand and seale the Nineteenth day of

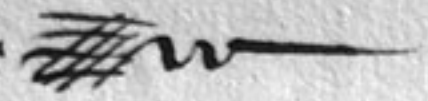
