of East Knoyle in the County of Wilts Yeoman. being of perfect
Understanding, but mindful of the Uncertainty of Human Life, do
make my last Will & Testament in Manner & Form following.
First, I give, devise & bequeath unto my loving Wife Elizabeth
for & during her Time, & as long as, she shall continue in a State
of Widowhood, the Annual Profits or Rents of all & singular
my Copyhold Mesuages Lands & Tenements (surrendered to the
Use of this my Will) which I stand seised of within the Manor of
Bishop's Knoyle. And from & after the Expiration of such her
State of Widowhood I give & devise the said Copyhold Mesuages
Lands & Tenements as follows. I give & devise unto my
Son Edward & his Heirs for ever the Ground called Burroughs
Allotment which I lately purchased of Thomas Osborne, which
Ground nevertheless I make subject to the Payment of Forty
Pounds I stand justly indebted to Jacob Street of Hindon.
I give & devise unto my Son Edward the new Shop standing near
my dwelling House, which he partly built. Item, I give &
devise unto my Daughter Elizabeth & her Heirs

I give & devise unto Son Edward w new Shop, standing near
my dwelling House, which He partly built. Item, I give &
devise unto my Daughter Elizabeth & her Heirs for ever, the
Ground lying between Parsonage Buses, & W Seymour's Horse
Close containing about an Acre & Half. Item, I give &
devise unto my Son John & his Heirs for ever my dwelling
House in Knowle Street together with w Orchard & Garden
adjoining, which I subject nevertheless, & charg'd with, the
Payment of ten Pounds to my Daughter Mary (wife to
Thomas Perry) to her separate Use, (her Coverture not regard-
ing) and ^{with} ~~of~~ ten Pounds to my Daughter Elizabeth, which
respective Sums of ten Pounds & ten Pounds to be paid
within one Year after my Son John shall be in Possession.
Item I give to my Daughter in Law Catherine five Shillings.

The rest & residue of my Estate of what kind or sort
soever I give & bequeath to my loving Wife whom I make
sole Executrix of this my Will. In Witnes whereof I have here
set my Hand & Seal this 26th day of April. Anno 1742
