At Sarum Apr. 5. 1757 by the
Rev. John Dumbley Clerk M.
of Arts lawful, Præboste of
the Rev. & worshipful Samuel
Lolleston Clerk Master of Arts
Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry
of Sarum. Admon of the god &c
of the Rev. Rich. Parsons was
granted to Betty Lockyer
wife of Wm Lockyer his near
& lawfull daughter being first
sworn that the Rev. decessed
intestate that she is faithfully
Administress & exhibitor of the
&c. upon which was made reg.

Know all Men by these Presents that We William
 Lockyer of North Petherton in the County of Somerset
 Plumber & Glazier Richard Godwin of Westbury in the
 County of Wilts Blacksmith and Samuel Piff
 of the City of New Sarum in the County of Wilts Baker
 are held and firmly bound unto the Right Worshipfull
 Samuel Rolleston Clerk Master of Arts Archdeacon
 of the Archdeaconry of Sarum
 in one Hundred and Twenty Pounds

of good and lawfull Money of Great Britain, to
 be paid unto the said Archdeacon or to
 his certain Attorney his Executors, Administrators or Assignes
 To which Payment well and truly to be made We oblige ourselves
 and each of us by him self for
 the whole out and each of our said Executors,
 and Administrators firmly by these Presents sealed with our seals
 Dated the Sixth Day of April in the
 Thirtieth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord
 George the Second - by the Grace of God of Great
 Britain, France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith and
 so forth, And in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
 Hundred and Fifty Seven.

The Condition of this Obligation is such, That if Betty Lockyer wife of the
 above bounden William Lockyer, Lawfull Daughter and
 Administratrix of all and singular the Goods, Chattels
 and Credits of Richard Parsons late of North Bradley Substante Deceased do
 make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods
 Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the Hands,
 Possession or Knowledge of her the said Betty Lockyer
 or into the Hands and Possession of any Person or Persons for her and
 the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the Archdeacon

or into the Lands and Possession of any Person or Persons for her and
the same do made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of the *Windsor*
of Sarum (if required) at or before the *Last* Day of *July*
next ensuing and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits and all other the Goods, Chattels
and Credits of the said Deceased at the time of his Death which at any time after
shall come to the Lands or Possession of the said *Betty Lockyer*
or into the Lands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for her do well and
truly administer according to Law; And further do make or cause to be made a true and
just Account of her said Administration at or before the *Last* Day of
April 1758 (if req^d.) and all the Rest and Residue of the said Goods, Chattels and Credits
which shall be found remaining upon the said Administrators Account the same being
first examined and allowed of by the Judge or Judges for the time being of the said Court
shall deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively as the said Judge or Judges
by his or their Decree or Sentence pursuant to the true Intent and Meaning of a late
Act of Parliament made in the two and twentieth and three and twentieth Years of the
Reign of our late Sovereign Lord King Charles the Second, intituled an Act for the
better settling of Intestates Estates shall limit and appoint; And if it shall hereafter appear
that any last Will and Testament was made by the said Deceased and the Executor or
Executors therein named do exhibit the same into the said Court making Request to have
it allowed and approved accordingly if the said *Betty Lockyer*
above bounden being therunto required do render and deliver the said Letters of Admini-
stration (Approbation of such Testament being first had and made) in the said Court;
then this Obligation to be Void, or else to remain in full force and Virtue.
