Estate and Effects given them by this my Will And I do hereby make constitute and appoint the said John Lea and William Fisher Executors In Trust of this my Will and also Guardians of the persons of such of my Children who shall be in their Minorities at my death during such their respective Minorities And I do hereby declare that my said Trustees shall not be answerable or accountable for any more of the said Trust Monies Estate and Effects than shall come to their hands respectively by virtue of this my Will nor for any involuntary loss which may happen to the same or any part thereof nor shall one of them be answerable for the Acts or Deeds of the other of them but each for his own Acts and Deeds only And I do hereby authorize and empower my said Trustees to deduct and reimburse themselves out of the said Trust Monies all such necessary Losses Charges and Expences as they or either of them shall be put unto in the Execution of the Trusts hereby in them reposed And Lastly I do Publish and Declare this to be my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I the said Testator Joseph Rose have to the first Sheet of this my Last Will and Testament (contained in two Sheets of Paper) Set my name and to this last Sheet thereof my name and Seal the Sixth day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty Seven.

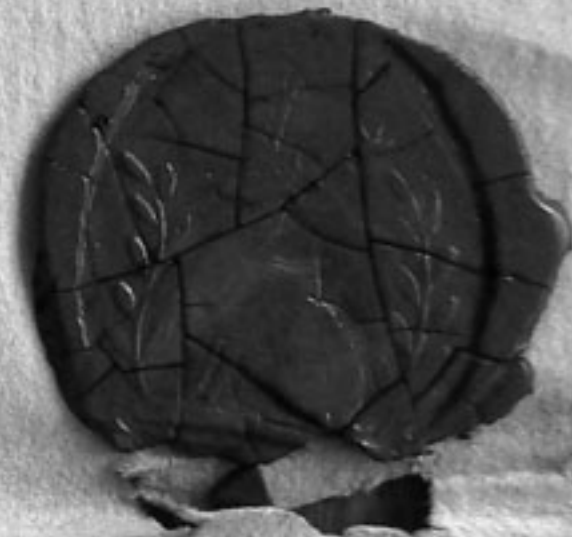
