and satisfied by my Executors hereinafter
out of my Personal Estate and Effects
I give and bequeath unto my Mother
Mrs Ann Shrapnell the Sum of Fifty
Pounds to and for her own use and
benefit I also give and bequeath unto
John Taylor of Bradford aforesaid
Druggist as a Token of my respect the
Sum of Ten pounds All the rest residue
and Remainder of my Estate and Effects
whatssoever and wheresoever and of what
nature kind or quality soever I reserve

whatsoever and wheresoever and of what
nature kind or quality soever the same
may be or consist which I shall or may
be supposed of interest in or entitled
unto at the time of my decease I give
devise and bequeath the same unto my
three Sisters Ann Shrapnell Elizabeth
Shrapnell and Caroline Shrapnell their
Heirs Executors Administrators and
assigns absolutely as Tenants in Common
and not as joint Tenants but in case my
said Sister Caroline Shrapnell who is
now a Minor shall die out this life
before she shall have attained her
age of Twenty one Years I give devise
and bequeath the whole share and interest
of my said Sister Caroline Shrapnell of
and in my said remaining Estate and

Effects and to which she would be
entitled under the devise herein before
contained unto and equally between
my said Sisters Ann Shapnell and
Elizabeth Shapnell then their Executors
administrators and assigns absolutely
as Tenants in Common whereas
my said Mother Ann Shapnell and my
Father William Shapnell are now
residing with me and my said Sisters
in my house in Bradford which I have
here since purchased and my desire
is that they should leave the same to
the sole occupation of my said Sisters
Now I do hereby will and direct that in
case my said Father and Mother should

case my said Father and Mother should
within six months next after my decease
quit possession of my said House and
Premises and relinquish the same to the
sole occupation of my said Sisters that
the legacy or sum of Fifty Pounds by
this my Will bequeathed to my said
Mother Ann Shrapnell shall fall into
and become part of my residuary
Estate and not be paid or become
payable And I do hereby nominate
constitute and appoint my said Sister
Ann Shrapnell and William Harvey
of Beaufield in the Parish of Bradford
as a said Gentleman Executor and

meaning is that it shall be lawful for her
and him respectively to retain and reimburse
herself and himself all such costs charges
and expences as she or he shall or may be
at sustain or be put unto in the execution
of this my will and that they shall not be
answerable the one for the other of them but
each of them for her and his own acts and
deeds only In witness whereof I have to
this my will written on three sides of a
Sheet of Paper set my hand and seal this
