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I know all men by these presents that we Robert Wires of
 Hindon in the County of Wilts Butcher, John Wickhams of the
 City of New Sarum in the said County Salisbury and William
 Purser of the said City Salisbury
 do acknowledge our selves to be hereby firmly bound unto
 the Right Worshipfull Samuel Rolliston Clerk Master of Arts
 Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry of Sarum in the Sum of fifty
 pounds of good & lawfull money of Great Britain to be paid
 to him or his certain Attorney Executors Administrators or
 assigns for the payment of which will & truly to be made
 we do by these presents sealed with our seals firmly bind our
 selves our Executors Executors & Administrators jointly and Separately for
 the payment of the whole Dated this Twenty seventh day
 of February in the year of our Lord One thousand seven
 hundred and Sixty five

The condition of this obligation is such That if the above-bounded Robert
 Wires Natural and lawfull son of Anne Wires late of Hindon aforesaid and
 her Archdeaconry of Sarum Widow Deceased and Administrator of all and
 singular the goods Chattels Rights and Credits of the said Anne Wires together
 with her last Will & Testament in Writing Annointed Executor or Executor
 being named therein shall and will well & duly execute & perform the said
 will and pay the debts & Legacies of the said Deceased so far forth as her goods
 Chattels & Credits will thereto extend & the Law bind him And also make
 or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the
 goods Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to
 the hands possession or knowledge of him the said Robert Wires or
 into the hands possession or knowledge of any other person or persons
 for him And the same to be made shall & he shall cause to be made & he shall

or persons as shall have a right to the same And as the Law shall direct
wherein the said Robert Wire shall be thereto lawfully required
Then this obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and
virtue.

Sam Rolleston William & Parsons

The last Will & Testam^t. of Ann Wire made
this 17th day of April in the Year of our Lord God 1764,
before the undermentioned witnesses.

This House I now live in / being in my
right Senses / I give & bequeath to my Son John
for one Year only, from the date here above mention^d
wthout wth liberty of selling the above house; w^{ch}
at wth expiration of one Year as above mention^d
shall become wth property of my Son Robert
for the remainder of the Lives of Peter Stevens
his Wife & their Daughter Ann.

The Bed I now lie on & everything thereto belonging
I bequeath to my Son James.

It is my last request wth ^{all} my sons allow
an equal share towards my burial, w^{ch} I hope will
be in a Christian manner.

The Chest of Drawers I likewise give to my
Son James.

The rest of my Effects I bestow on all my three
Sons in general, to be equally distributed between them
According to wth Judgm^t. of Luke Siley & Jos^{ph} Becket,
whom I appoint & intreat to do the same.

This is my last Will & Testam^t. w^{ch} I now make in
the presence of Jos^{ph} Noyes Minister
