The Eighth day of June in the Eleventh yeare of the reigne
of our Sovereigne Lord William the third by the Grace of God
King of England Scotland France and Ireland. I John Haddesly of the City of
New Sarum in the County of Wilts by me heretofore made doe my
last Will and Testament in manner following
viz first I commend my soule into the hands of Almighty my
Creator assuredly trusting through the meritts of Jesus Christ my
blessed Saviour and Redeemer to be made partaker of life everlasting
and my body I commit to the Earth in hope of a joyfull Resurrection
And as for that estate which God Almighty hath lent me I dispose
thereof in manner and forme following (that is to say) I give
unto my servant maid Mary Langhoy the summe of twenty shillings
of lawfull English money Item I give unto my brother Isaac Haddesly
and to his son John Haddesly and to Doctor Frederick Black the summe
of twenty shillings a peece of life money to buy each of them a ring
Item I give unto the poor of the Congregation of which I am Pastor
the summe of Ten pounds of life money to be disposed off by and
at the discretion of my Overseers hereafter named Item in con-
sideration that I have already given and paid unto my grand-
daughter Grace Curber the summe of Two hundred pounds of
lawfull money of England towards her advancement in marriage
I doe hereby give unto my Granddaughter Jane Masters spinster

the being weak in body but of
sound perfect memory revoking all
former wills and codicills of &c.

the like sume of Two Hundred pounds to ballance what I
have already given to my said granddaughter Turber Item I do
hereby give and bequeath unto my said granddaughter Grace Turber
all such share or moyety of my goodes thattells debto money plate
jewello implements of house and household stuffe as shall come to
her as being one of my Excutrixes of this my will to her whole and a
sole use and benefitt for her to have power to give or dispose of the same
at her will and pleasure by her will or any other writing under her
hand and seale attested by two or more Witnesses And it is my will
and pleasure that her husband shall have not power whatsoever to
dispose of the same till and since my goodes thattells debto money
plate jewello implements of house and household stuffe as above
given or bequeathed (my debto legatios and funeral expenses being
first paid and discharged) I do give and bequeath unto my said
granddaughter Grace Turber (in such manner as is before mentioned)
and to my said granddaughter Jane Master whom I do hereby
make and ordaine whole and sole Excutrixes jointly of this my last
Will and Testament And I do desire and appoint my son in
Law M^r John Masters and my very good friend M^r James Dristow
to be Overseers of this my last Will and Testament and to be
aiding and assisting to my said Excutrixes in the due execution
hereof And I do give to each of them in token of my love In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seale the day and yeare first above written. ~~~~
Witness whereof I have set my hand and seale John is addressly
signed sealed published and declared by the said Testator
John is addressly to be his last Will and Testament and the name
of us which are hereunto set as Witnesses subscribed in the
presence of each other and of the said Testator John Heabe
