Whereas I Henry Streater have omitted in my last Will
 and Testament the disposition of my little house and Garden now in
 the possession of John Peter with a field adjoining to it containing
 about one acre, little more or less now in my own occupation, lying
 and being in the parish of Bramshot, I doe hereby give and bequeath
 unto my Grand Daughters Mary Woods and Sarah Woods, and to the
 survivor of them, the said house Garden appurtenances and fields, and
 doe declare this to be part of my last Will and Testament in Witness
 whereof I the said Henry Streater have hereunto set my hand and
 sealed this Eighteenth Day of Feb: 1722. (Henry Streater.) signed sealed
 published and declared to be part of my last Will and Testament in
 the presence of us who have hereunto set our names in his presence (the
 marks of Joan Shiverton Elisabeth Coleman Ann Cartar. /

I Zachariah Shrapnell of Bradford in the County of Wilts Clothier being
 sick and weak in Body but of a sound and disposing Mind Memory
 and understanding do make and ordain this my last Will and Testam
 in manner and form following Inprimis I give devise and bequeath
 unto my loving Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell Eldest Son of my Brother
 Noah Shrapnell all those my Mesuages Lands Tenements and hereditam

with the appurtenances situate lying and being in the severall parishes
of Bradford aforesaid Winfield Crowbridge and elsewhere in the said
County of Wilts To hold to my said Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell his
heirs and assigns for ever subject and chargeable nevertheless in
such manner as the same is herein after subject and charged Item I
give and bequeath unto my said Brother Noah Shrapnell and Grace
his Wife Three hundred pounds of lawfull Mony of Great Britain to
be paid them within Twelve months after my decease upon Condition
nevertheless that he my said Brother Noah and his said Wife doe and
shall within one year after my decease by good and sufficient Deeds or
Deeds in the Law as the Court shall see meet in the Law of my said Nephew
Zachariah Shrapnell shall advise grant convey and assure unto my said
Nephew and to his heirs and assigns for ever all and singular the
Mesuages Lands Tenements Rents and hereditaments with the appur-
tances in the parish of Bradford aforesaid and the Reversion and Reversions
Remainder and Remainders thereof which were by Goods in the life time
of my said Father deceased & settled by him in Trust for me and which
upon my Death without Issue will by the said last mentioned Deeds
descend unto my said Brother by Survivorship And also doe and shall
in life manner within one year after my decease by good and
sufficient Deeds or Deeds or other Act or Acts in Law as the Court of
my said Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell shall advise Grant convey and
assure unto my said Nephew all that Mesuage Closes Lands and
hereditaments situate at Leigh in the parish of Bradford aforesaid with
my said Father gave to my said Brother Noah his heirs and
assigns To hold the said last mentioned Mesuages Closes Lands and
hereditaments with its appurtenances situate and being at Leigh aforesaid
from and immediately after the decease of him my said Brother Noah
unto my said Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell his heirs and assigns for ever
And in Case my said Brother Noah and his said Wife shall refuse to
execute such good and sufficient Deeds or Deeds in the Law to my said
Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell That then the Gift and bequest to them
of the said Three hundred pounds as aforesaid to be void and in such
Case I give and bequeath the same to my said Nephew Zachariah
Shrapnell his Executors Admin^{rs} and assigns Item I give and bequeath unto
the four Children of my said Brother Noah Shrapnell (to wit) unto my
Nephew John Shrapnell four hundred pounds to be paid him (with-
interest after his attainment of his age of Two and twenty years) when
he shall attain his age of Four and Twenty years and not before Item I
give and bequeath unto my Dear Aunt Shrapnell four hundred pounds
upon Condition she Marry by and with the Consent and approbation of
my said Brother Noah Shrapnell and John Woodward of Bradford Gent
or the Survivor of them to be paid her within Two years after my decease
And my Will further is that in Case my said Dear Aunt Shrapnell doe
shall not Marry by and with such Consent and approbation as aforesaid
That then and in such Case the Gift and bequest to her of the said
four hundred pounds to be void And I then give and bequeath the
same to my said Nephew Zachariah Shrapnell Item I give and bequeath
unto my Nephew Henry Shrapnell one hundred pounds to be paid
him within Two years after my decease Item I give and bequeath
unto my Dear Grace Woodbards Wife of Aron Woodbards of Taunton in
the County of Somerset fuller one annuity or yearly payment of five

pounds of lawfull money of Great Britain during her naturall life -
clear of all Deductions to be paid unto her owne separate Lands and
wherewith her said husband shall not have to doe or intermeddle by
equall quarterly payments by and out of the Rents and profits of my
Estate in Bradford aforesaid, I alsoe give and bequeath unto my said
Wife Grace Rodbard one hundred pounds to be paid within Twelve
Months after my decease And will the payment of all which said
Legarys aforesaid I doe hereby Charge all my Mesuages Lands Tenements
and hereditaments whatsoever so devised to my said Nephew Lathaniel
Shrapnell as aforesaid And my Will and Doine further is That if any
or either of my said Nephews or Wives John Shrapnell Henry Shrapnell
Ann Shrapnell and Grace Rodbard shall happen to dye before he she
or they shall respectively become entituled to his her or their Legary
or Legarys given by this my Will That then and in such Case the Legary
or Legarys of him her or them so dying shall goe to the survivor or
survivors of them my said Nephews and Wives equally to be divided
between them share and share alike provided always and it is the
true intent of this my Will That in Case my said Brother Noah and
his said Wife (if she shall be living one year after my decease) --
doe not or shall not on request to them for that purpose made make
and execute such Grants and Conveyances as aforesaid within the
time aforesaid to my said Nephew Lathaniel Shrapnell and his heirs
of the Lands aforesaid according to the true intent of this my Will That
then and in such Case the severall Legarys so given as aforesaid to
his said Children vizt the said John Shrapnell Ann Shrapnell Henry
Shrapnell and Grace Rodbard shall be void And I then give the same
Legarys to my said Nephew Lathaniel Shrapnell, Item I give and
bequeath unto my deare Sister Elizabeth Deane one annuity or yearly
payment of ffifteen pounds of lawfull money of Great Britain during
her naturall life clear of all Deductions whatsoever upon Condition
That she doe within Twelve Months after my decease Release unto my
said Brother Noah Shrapnell and to his heirs Executors and assigns all
such right Title and Interest that she hath or may have of in or to one
Annuity or yearly payment of ffive pounds payable to her during her
naturall life by my said Brother Noah Shrapnell by vertue of the last
Will and Testament of my deare Father deceased or by some other
wayes and means by and out of some part of the Lands aforesaid) to
be paid her by equall quarterly payments by and out of the Rents
Issues and profits of my Mesuages Lands and Tenements in Bradford
aforesaid and with the payment thereof I doe hereby Charge my Mesuages
Lands Tenements in Bradford aforesaid provided and if my said Sister
shall refuse to execute such Release to my said Brother Noah as aforesaid
That then and in such Case the said Gift and bequest of the said Annuity
of ffifteen pounds to be void And I then give and bequeath the same to
my said Nephew Lathaniel Shrapnell Item Whereas over and above
what I have already given to my Wife Elizabeth Davis another of the
Wives of my said Brother Noah Shrapnell on her Marriage with Henry
Davis of Frampton Cotterell in the County of Gloucester Gentlemen I have
promised to give one hundred pounds to such Child or Children to be
borne of their two Bodies as should live to attaine the age of one and
twenty years as they my said Nephew and Wife Henry Davis and Elizabeth
his Wife or out of them should direct and appoint Now in pursuance of

such promise (And if my said Nephew Henry Davis do and shall
execute a Bond to my Executor herein after named in a sufficient penalty
(according to his Agreement with me for that purpose) with Condition to
repay to my Executors or Assignes one hundred pounds of the Fortune
which he received of me with his said Wife in case she should happen to
die without Issue by the said Henry Davis) I doe hereby Will and appoint
borne as aforesaid and shall live to attain such age of one and twenty
years on his or her attainment of such age of one and twenty years as they
my said Nephew and Niece Henry Davis and Elizabeth Davis or out of them
shall order and direct by and out of my Lands so given to my said Nephew
Leitham Shrapnell. And with the payment thereof I doe hereby accordingly
Charge my said Lands so given and devised to my said Nephew Leitham
Shrapnell as aforesaid. Item I Give to my said deare Brother Noah and
Grace his Wife and to my deare Sister Elizabeth Deane And to my Cousin
Henry Davis and Elizabeth his Wife a Suite of Mourning to each and every
of them. Item I Give and bequeath unto my Cousin Samuel Shrapnell of
Bradford aforesaid from Wrouge and to my Cousin John Shrapnell Cloth-
Drawer and to Doctor Antlowe also of Bradford and to each of them Blank
Cloth sufficient to make them Mourning. Item I give to my Cousin John
Wailward of Bradford aforesaid dark Gray Cloth sufficient to make him
a Suite of Mourning. Item I Give and bequeath unto Mary Bishop the
now Wife of John Bishop of Bradford aforesaid Haberdasherie in Case she shall
survive her said Husband the use of their now dwelling house in Bradford
aforesaid she keeping the same in repair or of some other house in
Bradford equall in Value to the same at the Discretion of my Executor
herein after named for and during her naturall Life for her to inhabit
in but not to Lett or otherwise Dispose off. Item I give unto the said John
Bishop and Mary Bishop and to each of them a Suite of Mourning
suitable to their Degree and quality. Item I Give to John Harris of
Bradford aforesaid Husbandman and Ann his Wife and to each of them
a Suite of Mourning suitable to their Degree and quality. Item I Give and
bequeath unto the Poore of Bradford forty Shillings to be Dispose of
to them in Bread at the Discretion of my Executor herein after named
Item I Give and bequeath unto Peter Gibbs of Freshford and to the
said John Wailward Twenty pounds to be paid them or the survivor of
them within Two years after my decease in Trust and to and for such uses
 intents and purposes as I by any Writing under my hand for that
purpose attested by Two or more Credible Witnesses shall direct and appoint
Item I Give and bequeath unto William Bastfield Blank Cloth sufficient
to make him Mourning suitable to his Degree and quality. Item I give to
Elizabeth Bastfield Daughter of William Bastfield a Suite of Mourning
Item I Give and bequeath unto Thomas Kewill my said Nephew Leitham
Shrapnell's Apprentice one Guinea when he shall have served his said
Apprenticeship. And I doe hereby doo and appoint my said deare Brother
Noah Shrapnell and my said Cousin John Wailward to be overseers of this
my Will desiring that they will be aiding and assisting my Executor herein
after named in the Execution and performanc thereof. Item All the Rest
and Residue of my Estate both Real and personal not hereby devised Given
or bequeathed after payment of my Debts and Legacies I Give Devise
and bequeath to my said Nephew Leitham Shrapnell To hold to him
his heirs Executors Administrators and Assignes And him I doe hereby make

Hewitke, Eliza Crewhfeild and John Crewhfeild my Brothers to be my
lawfull Executors And after all my Accounts are made up the neat
produce of my Estate I leave as underneath mentioned viz. I leave and
bequeath to my son: Mother Elizabeth Crewhfeild my two Sisters
Elizabeth Hewitke and Anne Crewhfeild the sume of fifty pounds
sterling Money to each of them to buy them Mourning, And to my
